Community Based Services (CBS)

Tennyson Center for Children's CBS program gives hope to families across the front range by providing in-home therapy and support to children ages 0-18 with various mental health diagnoses and behaviors. The program focuses on keeping kids in loving homes and creating environments where they can be safe and thrive.

The program's primary emphasis is on the family unit: focusing on family therapy, preservation of the family unit, parenting education and skills, developing structure in the home, and support finding resources. CBS also provides in-school support as needed. Families are typically in our intensive in-home program from three months to one year.

CBS is Tennyson's fastest growing program. It began in the Denver metro area and has expanded to several Colorado counties, where it has been well received as a much needed resource.

Our Unique Approach

CBS staff work in teams of two, which includes a master's level clinician to provide therapy and a bachelor's level specialist to provide family and school support, which includes assisting with behavior management, home structure, and resources. This integration of two clinical perspectives creates a more comprehensive approach to treatment. The program is known for its clinical expertise working with trauma and attachment issues, family dynamics, and providing case management and resource support to families.

Connecting With Other Tennyson Programs

Tennyson programs work together to ensure that each child and family receives the level of care they need when they need it. CBS works closely with Tennyson's campus programs (day treatment and residential) to ensure smooth transitions and coordination of care.

Referrals

Tennyson collaborates with other professionals including occupational therapists, speech therapists, school staff, pediatricians, respite providers, and psychiatrists to ensure a comprehensive treatment approach.
