Layered Prevention Strategies

Phased Prevention

The plan will be reviewed in the next six months (August 2022).

Our school is in-person five days per week during the regularly scheduled times.

Social, Emotional, Mental and Other
Needs

Each student receives 120 minutes per week of individual and/or family therapy. Additionally, each classroom receives one to four groups per week by a clinician. Breakfast and lunch are served daily and are available to all students.

Masks will be required for students, staff, and visitors if there is an increase in the rate of COVID 19 in the community or school.

At home COVID testing provided to staff.

Handwashing and respiratory etiquette are taught and followed.

Staff and students are encouraged to stay home when sick and test for COVID 19.

Parents and staff are contacted when a positive case occurs in a classroom.

Cleaning and Disinfection daily.
