Day Treatment & Education – Fully accredited school

Offers a wide spectrum of mental and behavioral health support for children, youth, and families—meeting people where they are, in their homes, communities and on the Tennyson campus. serving students K-12

BRANCH (Behavior Resources for Adaptive Needs in the Community and Home) Intensive in-home support for youth with developmental disabilities, trauma, autism, and co-occurring mental health needs. serving students 5-18

ASPEN (Adaptive Skills for People with Emotional Needs):

Serving students whose educational disabilities and/or mental health needs require smaller class sizes, more individualized structure and a deeply therapeutic environment. serving students K-12

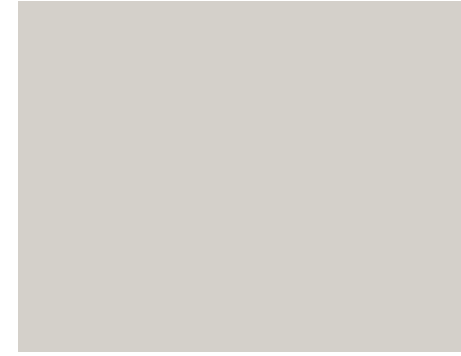
